Glassworks Cooperative Inc. plans to establish a land trust and facilitate the development of an attainable, mixed use, netzero community on our 46-acre parcel of land fronting on 23rd Avenue and 26th Avenue East in Owen Sound.

Currently zoned M2 and partially farmed, the Glassworks Cooperative Inc. property was acquired early in 2021 as our preferred site for development.
